Dear Parents/ Carers,

We are delighted that your child has been offered a place at Moorlands Schools Federation, starting in September 2020. This is the beginning of a long and fulfilling relationship, where we look forward to working alongside you and your child. As a school, our children and their needs are always at the heart of what we do and starting school for the first time is a very important stage in your child's life.

Your child will either be in the Ladybird or Bumblebee class. Our EYFS classes work in one space and so the children mix every day and will be grouped for different activities with children from both classes. They will spend much of their time playing and learning together so please do not worry if some of your child's friends are in the other class; reassure your child that they will all share one space and play and learn together. We will confirm your child's class in July in writing.

Due to the current situation, we unfortunately have had to cancel our induction meeting (Thursday 4th June) in order to keep everyone safe whilst following the government guidance.
