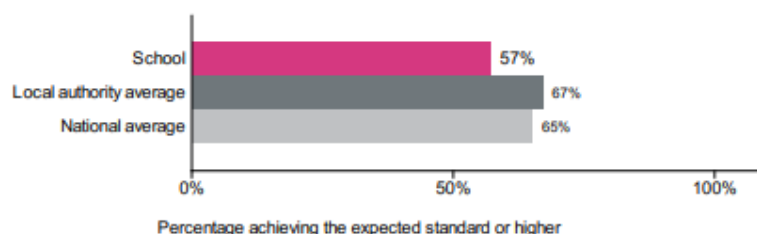

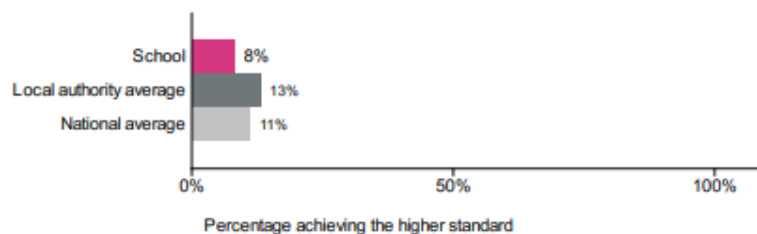

##### Percentage of pupils achieving the higher standard

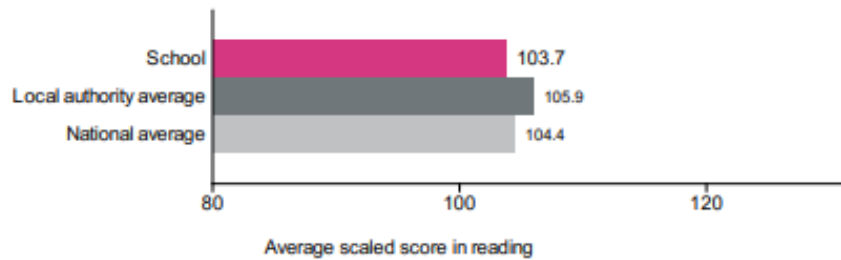

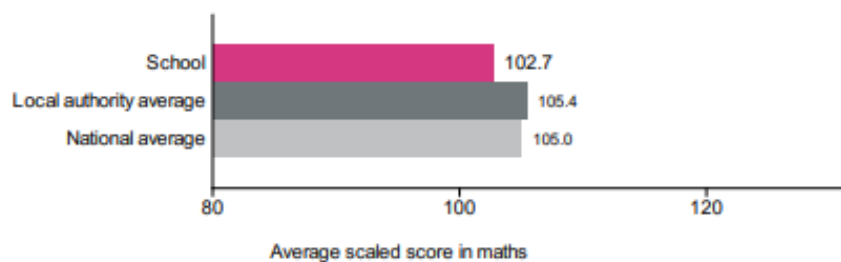

## Junior schools

We know from national data that pupils at junior schools, on average, have higher attainment scores at the end of key stage 2 than pupils at all other primary schools. 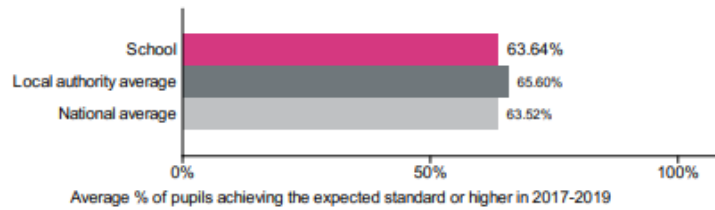

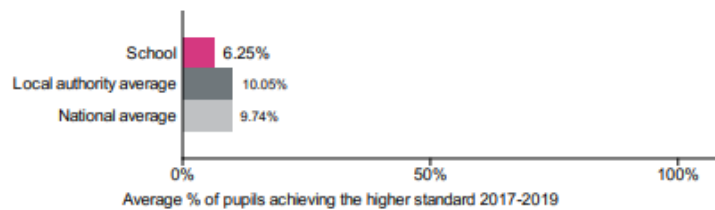


### Percentage of pupils achieving higher standard in reading, writing and maths, 2017-2019

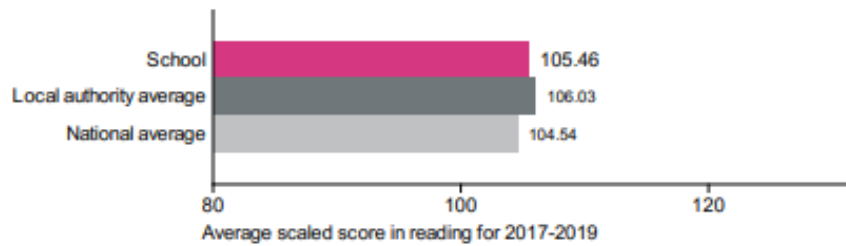

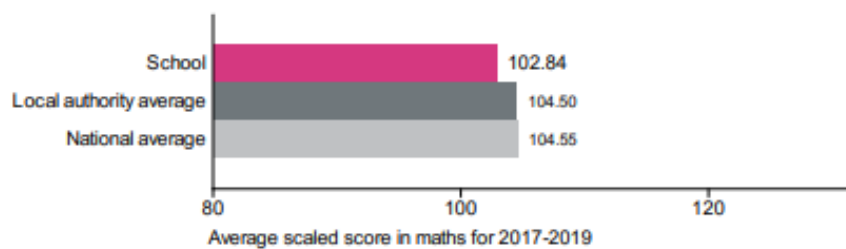


### Maths, 2017-2019

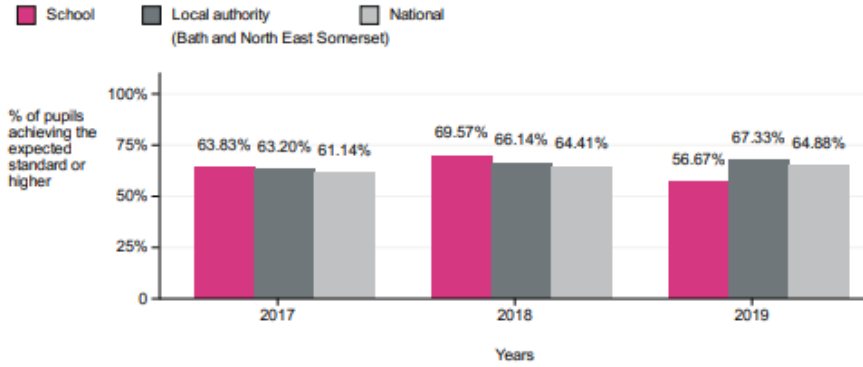
